Scholarship Rules under CSR

1. Objective

The scholarship program at Ram Chameli Chadha Vishvas Girls' College aims to empower young women by providing financial support for their higher education. Sponsored under a Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiative, this scholarship is designed to assist academically bright and economically disadvantaged students in pursuing their educational goals.

2. Scholarship Scope

2.1 Coverage

Full Tuition Fee for the academic year & certification programs cost

2.2 Additional Benefits

Participation in mentoring programs, career guidance, and leadership workshops. Access to exclusive internships and training opportunities provided by the CSR partner.

3. Eligibility Criteria

3.1 Academic Criteria

Applicants must have secured a minimum of 60% marks in the last qualifying examination (Class XII for first-year students, or previous year's result for current students).

Scholarship renewal requires maintaining a minimum 65% aggregate in each semester or academic year.

3.2 Financial Need

Annual family income should not exceed ₹2,00,000 (income certificate issued by a competent authority is mandatory).

Priority will be given to students from economically weaker sections, minority communities, or marginalized backgrounds.

3.3 Enrollment

The student must be enrolled in a full-time undergraduate program at Ram Chameli Chadha Vishvas Girls' Degree College.

3.4 Attendance

Students must maintain a minimum of 75% attendance in all classes, unless exempted due to valid reasons (e.g., medical grounds).

4. Application Process.

4.1 How to Apply

- Applications are available at the college office and on the college's official website.
- Students must submit the following documents along with the completed application form:
- Copies of academic transcripts and mark sheets.
- Income certificate from a competent authority.
- Aadhaar card or other government-issued ID.
- Bank account details for scholarship fund disbursal.

4.2 Deadline

Applications must be submitted by specify date for consideration in the upcoming academic year. Late applications will not be entertained.

4.3 Selection Process

The Scholarship Committee, comprising college representatives and CSR partner representatives, will review applications.

Selection will be based on academic merit, financial need, and personal interviews (if applicable).

5. Scholarship Renewal

5.1 Renewal Criteria

Submission of an academic performance report and attendance record for the preceding year.

Updated income certificate to confirm continued financial need.

Active participation in community service or CSR initiatives organized by the college or sponsoring organization.

5.2 Grounds for Disqualification

Failure to meet academic or attendance requirements.

Misrepresentation of information during the application process.

Disciplinary actions or behaviour deemed inappropriate by college authorities.

6. Terms and Conditions

Scholarships are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or any other benefits. In case of a student withdrawing from the program or being expelled, the scholarship will be forfeited, and any unused funds must be returned.
