## **SUPPORT TO GAUSHALAS, CHARITABLE CAUSES, AND NGOS :**

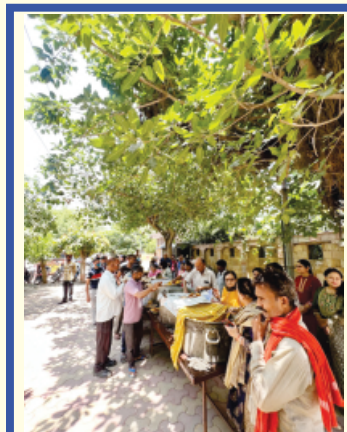

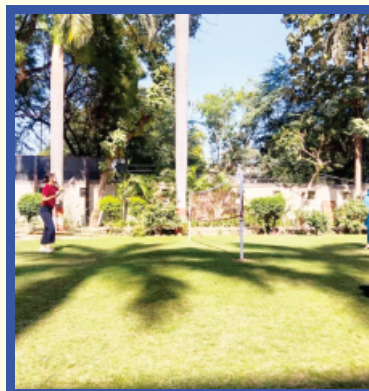
